

Writing an Article

What is an article?

An article is usually written for a magazine or newspaper. It is usually <u>semi-formal</u> and <u>similar</u> to a direct conversation with the reader.

What is the purpose?

To inform and engage the reader with a topic that they are probably interested in.

Title	Use language in the question or invent your own, relevant title. (Think: 'clickbait').
Introduce the topic	Involve the reader by addressing them directly. You could ask a rhetorical question.
	 Just imagine Have you ever? How would you feel if? Are you one of those people who? If the answer is, you should What would life be like if
	Remember: this is <u>not</u> an essay. In an essay we usually state the content of the text in the introduction. This should not be done in an article. Why? Because the purpose is to engage the reader and to encourage them to read more.
Develop the topic and ideas	You can use subheadings to divide ideas and make the article easier to read.

	Include your opinion and, if suitable for the context, humour.
	You can also include quotes "" and examples.
	If you ask questions, limit them to one per paragraph.

	You could end with a question addressed to the reader or you could state your opinion after having given the information within the article. Is your opinion the same as when you started writing, or has it changed?
